This session aims to present the deportation of Jews from territories under Bulgarian occupation during World War II (Western Thrace and Eastern Macedonia in Greece; Vardar Macedonia and the region of Pirot in Yugoslavia), as well as the ultimate refusal of Bulgarian authorities to deport Jews from the “old” kingdom (Bulgaria’s pre-1941 boundaries). The lecture uses visual and print archives, which are brought together in a PowerPoint presentation.
