Zuzana Pavlovská is the Head of the Department for Education and Culture of the Jewish Museum in Prague since 2011. She is involved in several educational projects. These include the hugely successful “Neighbours who Disappeared” and in cooperation with the Terezín Initiative Institute “Ours or Foreign? Jews in the Czech Twentieth Century”. Zuzana also lectured at the Charles University courses Jewish studies and Modern Hebrew. She collaborates with various Holocaust centers, where she gave several lectures e.g. The Johannesburg Holocaust Genocide Center and their branches in Durban and Cape Town and with Beit Terezin in Israel.

Zuzana studied at the Charles University in Prague, Hebrew University in Jerusalem. In 2019 finished Ph.D. studies and wrote a thesis dedicated to the topic of women’s role in the Haskalah. Currently she is representing Czech Republic within the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance IHRA and in 2020 was a Chair of the Educational Working Group.
