The Hungarian minority in the region

The main aim of this historical lecture is to present the circumstances and main political events that has happened to the Hungarian community in Romania during the interwar period. This comprehends the presentation of the chronology of the events from 1918, and the first years of political passivism, up until 1938, reflecting on the main political, economic and cultural organizations and self-definitions of the community, such as transylvaniam. For learning tools, I will use Power Point presentation along with a few primary sources as examples, and to learning goal would be to understand the main process of the strategies on co-existence of the Hungarian community in the interwar period.
