## The participant-centered methodology

Miklós Vas is a Junior Researcher at Zachor Foundation for Social Remembrance. From 2019 he studied History, Politics and Economics for two years at University College London. He is currently a BA student in History with Russian language as a minor at Eotvos Lorand University, Budapest. His main interests in history are ranging from oral history, holocaust studies to history of ideas and remembrance. At Zachor Foundation he participates in youth programs, guides interactive tours in the Jewish quarter of Budapest and develops educational materials for secondary school students. Throughout his work, he finds pedagogical skills and practices equally important to professional knowledge.

Gabriella Komoly is the manager of international educational and research programs at Zachor Foundation, an educational NGO in Budapest, Hungary. She's been conducting interviews with elderly bystanders and survivors of the Holocaust since 2014 as member of two research groups (USHMM: Perpetrators, Collaborators, and Witnesses: The Jeff and Toby Herr Testimony Initiative, Eötvös Loránd Science University: Multidisciplinary Research about witnesses of the Holocaust). She is the author of several local-history educational programs as well as other testimony-based educational materials. She is currently studying psychology at the University of Pécs in Hungary.
