Marta Verginella is a Full Professor in the History Department of the University of Ljubljana, where she teaches History of the 19th Century and Theory of History. Her work focuses on social history and general history, with a particular interest in nationalization processes in the northern Adriatic in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. One aspect of her studies concerns memory and its political use in Slovenia and along the Slovenian-Italian border. She directs the European Research Council's Project EIRENE, which focuses on the condition of women in the border areas of the northern Adriatic during the post-war eras of the 20th century: *Il confine degli altri* (Donzelli 2008) and *La guerra di Bruno* (Donzelli 2015); *Terre e lasciti. Pratiche testamentarie nel contado triestino fra Otto e Novecento* (Beit 2016); *Slovenka. Il primo giornale femminile sloveno (1897-1902)* (Vita Activa 2019), *Donne e confini* (Manifesto libri 2021), *Ženske in meje* (2022).
