Tal Bruttmann is a French historian. Researcher associated with the EHESS, his work is related to the antisemitic policies in France during the war and to the «final solution» in Europe. For instance, he is the author of *La Logique des bourreaux* (Hachette Littératures, 2003), *Au bureau des Affaires juives. L'administration française et l'application de la législation antisémitique, 1940-1944* (La Découverte, 2006) et *Aryanisation économique et spoliation en Isère* (Presses universitaires de Grenoble, 2010). He also published in 2015 an essay about the history of Auschwitz in 2015 and he wrote with the historian Christophe Tarricone *Les 100 mots de la Shoah* (PUF, Que sais-je) in 2016.
