

## Speaker : Valerija Turk-Presečki

Workshop *Eva Fischer - Holocaust in colors* deals with the theme of the Holocaust in fine arts. Eva Fischer was a world-renowned painter of peculiar creativity and life whose works dealt with the theme of the suffering of Jewish people in the Holocaust. Participants will get acquainted with the theoretical background of artworks created during and after the Holocaust and the strategies for using them in teaching process. Teachers will work in groups. The aim is to analyze the selected examples of Eva Fischer's paintings. At the end of the workshop, the group work results will be presented to other participants, followed by a reflection on the importance of using artwork as a source for learning and teaching about the Holocaust.

Participants will:

- explore how to use various approaches to Holocaust art in teaching the Holocaust to students
- consider the Holocaust artwork as a form of expression and as a historical source
- interpret the artistic aspects of Eva Fischer's painting and discuss the questions they raise.
