Debates regarding 'problematic' historical events: Bleiburg, povojni poboji, Foibe

Jovana Mihajlović Trbovc is a research associate at the Institute for Culture and Memory Studies of the Research Centre of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts and assistant professor in cultural history at the University of Nova Gorica. She was awarded the 2015 Jean Blondel PhD Prize for the best thesis in politics issued by the European Consortium for Political Research for the thesis relating to impact of war crime trials on memory of war in Bosnia. During her doctoral studies, she worked at the Peace Institute, Ljubljana. Her research focus is at the meeting point of memory studies, political science, cultural and gender studies. She extensively published on the topics of social memory, particularly as reproduced in history textbooks, in relation to the Yugoslav Wars of the 1990s and World War II. She has been also researching the history of feminism and women's intellectual work during socialism, while working on issues related to gender equality in academia.
