Dieter Pohl is Professor for Contemporary History at the University of Klagenfurt (Austria). His research focus is on Nazi history, German occupation and extermination policies in occupied Eastern Europe, global Second World War history, and history of communist systems, esp. in the GDR and the Soviet Union. He published „Nationalsozialistische Judenverfolgung in Ostgalizien 1941-1944“ (1996), „Justiz in Brandenburg 1945-1955.“ (2001), „Die Herrschaft der Wehrmacht. Deutsche Militärbesatzung und einheimische Bevölkerung in der Sowjetunion 1941-1944“ (2008), and is co-editor of Heinrich Himmler's service diaries 1941/42 and 1943-1945 (1999 und 2020), and co-editor of the 16 volume document edition „Die Verfolgung und Ermordung der europäischen Juden durch das nationalsozialistische Deutschland 1933-1945“ (2008-2021, english version currently being published). Last month appeared his book „Nationalsozialistische Verbrechen“.
