Her research focuses on Greece's political, diplomatic, military and educational relations with Bulgaria and Turkey in the 19th and 20th centuries and the issues of memory of the Balkan peoples and refugees and how they affect the construction and maintenance of a distinct identity within modern societies. She has published extensively on such topics.

She speaks English, French but also Bulgarian language, as she has a master's degree from the Neofit Rilski University in Blagoevgrad, Bulgaria.
