His PhD thesis is related to "*The Repatriation and Rehabilitation of the Greek Displaced Persons from Axis Countries during the decade of 1940 by United Nations Relief and Rehabilitation Administration (UNRRA) and its successor International Refugee Organization (IRO) and the work of United Nation in Greece 1944 - 1950*". Moreover, he is a Research Fellow at the Endowed Chair of Pontic Studies in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He has conducted research in the Diplomatic and Historical Archive of Greek Ministry of Foreign Affairs, British National Archives, United Nations Archives, Rockefeller Archive Center, and the Archive of Burke Missionary Library of Columbia University.
