Mišo Dokmanović

Prof. dr. iur Mišo Dokmanović is Full Professor at the School of law, Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje. He teaches courses History of Law and Contemporary Macedonian History at the undergraduate studies and Balkans and US Diplomacy and Contemporary History and Diplomacy of the Middle East at the MA program.

Dr. Dokmanović holds LLB (2003), LLM (2006) and PhD (2010) degrees from Ss. Cyril and Methodius University in Skopje as well as MA in Contemporary Diplomacy (with distinction) from the Mediterranean Academy for Diplomatic Studies, University of Malta and DiploFoundation – Geneva (2006).

In October 2017 dr. Dokmanović has been appointed a Member of the Delegation of the Republic of North Macedonia to the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance in charge of the Academic Working group. Dr. Dokmanović was President of the Macedonian American Alumni Association (2017-2019) and President of the Executive Board of the Institute for Strategic Research and Education.

He has participated in conferences, study visits and lectured in over 50 countries. Dr. Dokmanović was a Research/Visiting Fellow and Lecturer at a number of leading academic institutions including Princeton University, University of Michigan, University of Florida, University of Illinois, universities in Bonn, Graz, Vienna, Poznan, Moscow, Cracow etc. In the summer of 2010 he attended the US Department of State - Study of the US Institute on American Foreign Policy. In the period January – February 2017 dr. Dokmanovic was a Research Fellow of Swiss Center of Expertise in Social Sciences – Lausanne where he worked on innovative research methodologies in social sciences.

During his career, professor Dokmanović attended a number of conferences organized by Institute of National Remembrance – Bratislava, Institute of National Remembrance – Warsaw, WU- Vienna University for Business and Administration, Middle Eastern Technical University – Ankara, Georgetown University, universities in Aarhus, Helsinki, St. Petersburg, Tallinn, Macerata, Dallas, Salzburg Global Seminar, Karnataka Legislature, MFA Malta, Neuwaldegg Institute-Vienna, Bled Forum on Europe, DCAF Geneva, ELIAMEP – Athens, Institute for Public Policy – Timisoara etc.

In 2014 he was awarded the highest recognition for teaching and academic excellence – Scientist of the Year Award. He is the youngest recipient of the award ever.

Professor Dokmanović has attended 2008 Yad Vashem School on Holocaust Studies in Jerusalem and co-authored the official Ann Frank exhibition in North Macedonia. He regularly attends events related to the history of Jews and is a regular lecturer at the International Seminar for History Educators organized by Mémorial de la Shoah – Paris. He also initiated the naming of the Bitola hospital by the name of the famous Jewish doctor – Haim Abravanel.
