### **Roumen Avramov**

**Roumen Avramov** is an economist and historian. He has been working in the fields of economic history, macroeconomics and monetary economics. During the last decade he has researched the economics of inter-ethnic conflicts, namely those with the Greek, Jewish and Turkish minorities in Bulgaria. Books dedicated to Jewish studies (in Bulgarian): *“Salvation” and Abjection. Microeconomics of State Anti-Semitism in Bulgaria, 1940-1944* (Sofia University Press, 2012); *The Deportation of the Jews from Vardar’s Macedonia, Western Thrace, and Pirot. March 1943. Documents from the Bulgarian Archives* (vol. 1-2, 2013) (co-edited with Nadia Danova).

Before retiring from the Centre for Advanced Study Sofia in 2020, R. Avramov has been with the Institute of Economics of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences (1976-1990); Vice-President of the Agency for Economic Coordination and Development of the Bulgarian Government (1991-1994); Member of the Board of Governors of the Bulgarian National Bank (1997-2002); and with the Centre for Liberal strategies in Sofia (1995-2012).
