Pedro Aires Oliveira (b. 1971) is an Associate Professor at Universidade NOVA de Lisboa. He holds a PhD in Contemporary History and is an integrated researcher at the Institute of Contemporary History, a research unit he directs since December 2015.

He is the author, co-author and editor of several books on Portuguese overseas/imperial history, such as *Os Despojos da Aliança. A Grã-Bretanha e a Questão Colonial Portuguesa 1945-75* (2007), *História da Expansão e do Império Português* (with J. P. Costa e José Damião Rodrigues, 2014) *O Adeus ao Império. 40 anos de Descolonização Portuguesa* (co-edited with F. Rosas e M. Machaqueiro, 2015) and *1961* (co-author with António Tomás, 2019). He has published several articles in national and international journals (*Civil Wars, Portuguese Studies, Cold War History, International History Review, Contemporary History Review*).

He has supervised various MA and PhD dissertations on related topics and is currently one of the coordinators of the Erasmus Mundus MA programme «History in the Public Sphere», a consortium integrated by the Central European University, Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, University of Florence and NOVA.
