Tal Bruttman is a French historian. Researcher associated with the EHESS, his work is related to the antisemitic policies in France during the war and to the « final solution » in Europe. For instance, he is the author of *La Logique des bourreaux* (Hachette Littératures, 2003), *Au bureau des Affaires juives. L'administration française et l'application de la législation antisémite, 1940-1944* (La Découverte, 2006) et *Aryanisation économique et spoliation en Isère* (Presses universitaires de Grenoble, 2010). He also published in 2015 an essay about the history of Auschwitz in 2015 and he wrote with the historian Christophe Tarricone *Les 100 mots de la Shoah* (PUF, Que sais-je) in 2016.
